  - High-Speed Broad Band Internet Access Services,
  - Unified Communication Services (voice, data, video & text) and

Telepresence Value Added e-Services (VAS) like: TeleMedicine, TeleNursing, Distance Education (Teaching/Learning), Education Shared Services, eCommerce, e-Gov't Services, etc.


#### **Our Vision**

Video Conferencing Services	<b>Events:</b> Conferences, Seminars, Team Building, Distance Learning, e-Workshops, Public Rallies, etc.; organised by NGOs, Gov't and Private Entities; and hosted by the RABBIN Local Owner <b>RABBIN Services &amp; Fees:</b> Internet access for video streaming sessions; \$USD/hr to be determined per event by the Location Owner based on DCD recommendations. Other Value Added Services (VAS)	Events & Occasions: Internet Cafes, Conferences, Seminars, Team Building, Distance Learning, e-Workshops, etc.; organised by NGOs, Gov't and Private Entities and RABBIN Local Owner RABBIN Services & Fees: The RABBIN Location Owner has the opportunities to develop and provide own extra services like Food, Accommodation and Entertainment during/for the listed events and occasions but not only. This also contributes to more purchase of visitor vouchers for internet access; and above all huge additional income for the RABBIN Location Owner.


Revenue Share: 85% of the Total Sales Revenue

- h) Technical Training for the Network Owner,

- j) Assist the Network Owner to search for Project Funding.

### **PROJECT FUNDING PROCEDURE**



We (at DCD) help the Community Based Organizations, Business Entrepreneurs, NGOs, Universities, Medical Units, Gov't Local Offices, Social Community Centres, Tourist and Hotel Chains; and other Individuals/Organizations, who/that intend to build and operate the RABBIN/PUN to:

- Get a MOU (Memorandum of Understanding) Agreement between DCD and the future RABBIN/PUN Owner;
- Choose Network Site Location(s), where to setup the Wi-Fi Hubs and Hotspots; and
- Prepare the Business Plan for Telepresence deployment in the chosen site location(s); and
- Setup a Pilot Project Specification Plan based on the Business Financial Plan; and
- Present both the Business Financial and Pilot Project Plans to Financers; and
- Get the funding in place for pilot project rollout; and
- Implement (Roll-Out) the Pilot Project as planned; and
- Conduct Risk Evaluation and Assessment based on the Pilot Project; and
- Review both the Business Financial Plan and the Project Specification Plan; and
- Make decisions for further project activities; and
- Consider additional business for value added services like: accommodation, gastronomic services, leisure & tourism services, etc.
